I ran and co-taught the 4-hour seminars with a faculty instructor, beyond which I also mentored students on their weekly K-12 engagement and facilitated them from observing, co-teaching, to eventually teaching their own lessons. At the end of each semester, I visited each student's class to observe their teaching performance and provided feedback.

I acted as a TA in co-teaching the online course-*Instroduction to E-learning* in LDT program. I participated in every phase of teaching including greeting students, monitoring and being involved in online discussions, grading and providing feedback on assignments.

I taught 6-8th graders in Abbott Middle School and Orchard Lake Middle School for two years. I designed and delivered inquiry-based lessons by integrating technology for students' collaboration, engagement, and evaluation. The technological integration showed me both the power and limitation in using technology tools in K-12 classrooms, which motivated me to pursue my PhD degree in LDT. My implementation of authentic learning strategies such as evaluating students' learning in authentic contexts provided students with new and unforgettable experience compared with traditional classroom learning. One group of my students participated in Michigan Chinese competition and got the second place.
